September 18, 2026 - "Oasis In Space"

Liquid water is a critical requirement for life, so our search for extraterrestrials begins by looking for water. Join us as we tour our solar system in a search for water in our local neighborhood in this show from COSM/Spitz Incorporated.

October 16, 2026 - "Astronaut"

What does it take to become an astronaut? What kind of hazards do astronauts face in space? Discover the perils that lurk in space as we subject "Chad", our test astronaut, to everything that space has to throw at him in this immersive show from the National Space Center in England. Narrated by Ewan McGregor.

November 13, 2026 - "Fall Skies"

As milder weather returns the familiar constellations of Spring reappear. Join us as we show you how to find these constellations in the evening sky, and take a humorous look at the myths behind them.

December 11, 2026 - "Incoming!"

Asteroids and comets have collided with our planet throughout history, changing the Earth and shaping our world. In this show viewers will journey on the trail of asteroids and comets, and get a look at the technologies that allow scientists to detect them before they reach Earth. Narrated by George Takei, *Incoming!* examines the past, present and future of our Solar System in this full-dome presentation.

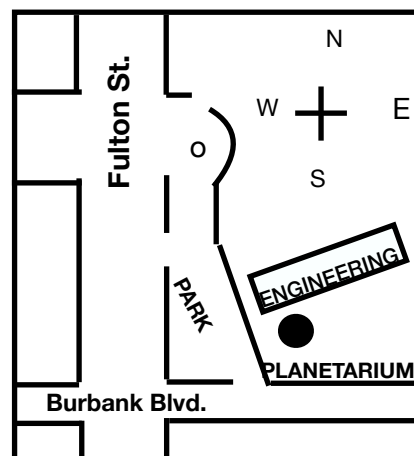
